- E Hold a current work permit, as defined by the immigration act 1971, as a hockey player in the United Kingdom and hold a passport for a country with whom the European Union has an agreement containing provisions prohibiting discrimination in employment.
- F Have NONE of the above and are Registering as an Overseas Player
